

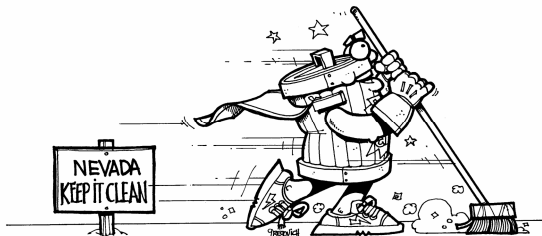
FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008

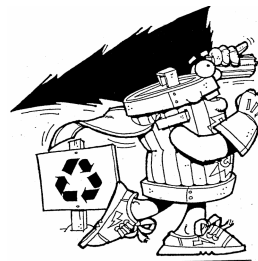
