

Recycling Guide for the Truckee Meadows

Curbside Recycling is available for single family homes.

What **CAN** be recycled curbside:

Yellow Crate

Aluminum Cans

Steel Cans

Tin Cans

Plastic Bottles

Green Crate

Clear glass bottles and jars

Green glass bottles and jars

Brown glass bottles and jars

Brown paper bag or reusable container

(not provided by Waste Management)

Newspaper

Magazines

Catalogs

*Phone books can be placed on top

Items can be recycled with the labels still on. Please remove lids and rinse if heavily soiled with food residue.

What **CANNOT** be recycled curbside:

Plastic bags

Plastic yogurt and butter tubs, strawberry containers, laundry scoops or anything else that is not a plastic bottle (#5 plastics can be taken to Whole Foods for recycling)

Paperboard – cereal boxes, etc.

Drinking glasses, Pyrex or other glass containers/items that aren't bottles or jars

Yard Waste

*Junk Mail

*Corrugated Cardboard – paperboard or corrugated cardboard

**Light bulbs of any kind

Recycling Drop-Off Locations – Will take the **same** items as **curbside recycling**

Smiths Shopping Center – Baring Blvd, Sparks

North Entrance to Scolari's – Mira Loma and McCarran, Reno

Recycling Centers – Will take the **same** items as **curbside recycling** AND * items

Open Monday – Friday 8:30am – 4:30pm

Waste Management Recycle America – 1100 E. Commercial Row, Reno

Waste Management Recycle America – 1455 E. Greg Street, Sparks

**Waste Management Recycling Centers and Transfer Stations and Home Depot will take household "pig tail" shaped Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFL) for recycling free of charge. Waste Management will take fluorescent tubes for a \$3 fee.
