Disposal of Common Items

FURNITURE/LARGE APPLIANCES: City of Reno, Sparks, and unincorporated Washoe County Waste Management residential customers may dispose of one standard pickup truck (not to exceed three cubic yards) of trash four times a year at no cost anytime during the transfer stations' normal operating schedule. Customers must be current on their bill and have proof of residence.

PAINT: Latex paint can be left out to dry or mixed with cat litter/sand and then thrown in the trash.

PHONEBOOKS: Visit yellowpagesoptout.com to stop delivery of phonebooks to your door.

REFUSE PLASTIC BAGS: Bring your own bag instead! Plastic shopping bags cannot be recycled curbside, but they can be recycled by taking them back to some grocery stores. For example, Walmart, Whole Foods, Savemart, etc.

REDUCE and REUSE IDEAS: Pinterest, Craigslist free listings, and the Facebook Marketplace have great ideas on ways to **reuse**. Visit Savers, Junkee, Goodwill, Plato's Closet, Salvation Army & other charity thrift stores. Remember to shop bulk to **reduce** waste associated with packaging.
